

Ghanian Kente Watercolor Salt Project

Materials Required

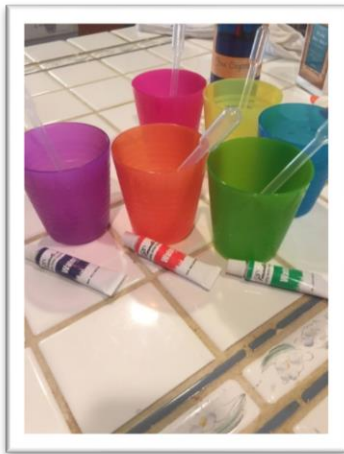
- glue
- salt
- 6 pipettes
- 6 watercolor ovals, watercolor paint **or** liquid watercolor
- water
- 6 cups
- outline map of Africa on cardstock
- Kente Cloth Color Significance
- tray



Step 1:

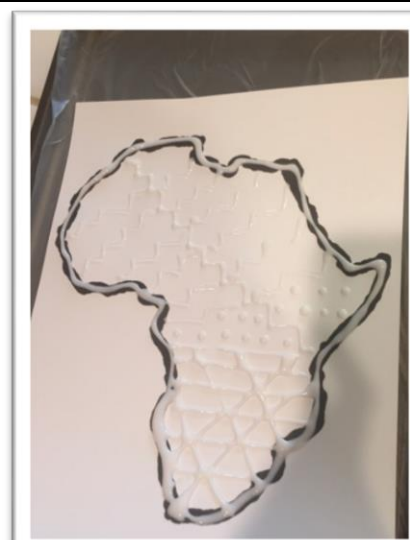
Drop 1 – 2 oz of water in each cup and place one oval or a generous squeeze of watercolor paint and make sure the paint dissolves completely

Or, for \$9 you can buy liquid watercolor



Step 2:

Using glue, trace the outline of Africa's border and draw geometric patterns



Step 3:

Generously shake salt all over project while glue is still wet

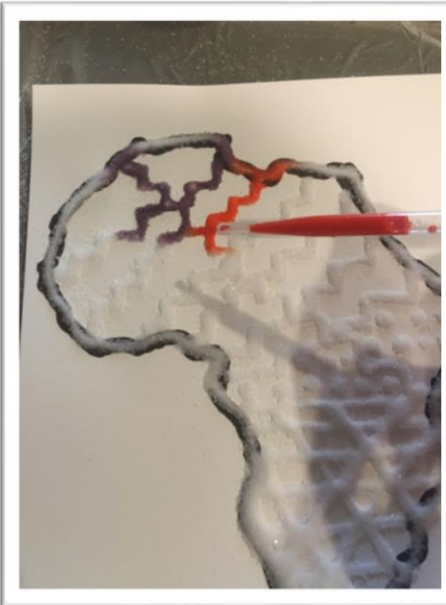


Step 4:

read Kente Cloth Color Significance while waiting 2 – 3 minutes for glue to dry

use pipettes to carefully drop watercolor onto the salt

tips: do not over saturate salt glue lines; less is more



Step 5:

let project dry for at least 15 – 25 minutes before allowing students to take them home
